Public Meeting Invitation

Dear Sir/Madam:

The Butler County Engineer's Office (BCEO) is proposing improvements to the intersection of Hamilton Mason Road / Tylersville Road / Grand Boulevard / Hancock Avenue / Tuley Road on the City of Hamilton / Fairfield Township border in Butler County, Ohio. This intersection is also referred to locally as the Five Points intersection. A map of the project area is enclosed with this letter. Proposed improvements include converting the five-road intersection to a roundabout intersection with curb and gutter, proper storm drainage, safer roadway geometrics, and improved pedestrian facilities. The project is tentatively scheduled for construction in 2021. Environmental issues related to Regulated Materials, Cultural Resources, and potential impacts to Environmental Justice communities are being investigated as part of the environmental studies.

The BCEO is hosting an open house style public meeting to present information and receive feedback from the public regarding this proposed project. Meeting date, time, and location are as follows:
