**RE: Proposed Five Points Intersection Improvement Project
BUT-Five Points Roundabout, PID 106129**

Dear Public Meeting Participant:

Thank you for attending the public meeting held September 19, 2018 for the BUT-Five Points Roundabout project. A total of 60 individuals attended the meeting and we received 12 comments during the public comment period from September 19, 2018 to October 19, 2018. A summary of the comments received and the Butler County Engineer's Office's (BCEO's) responses to the comments are enclosed with this letter.

Following the public meeting, the BCEO and City of Hamilton identified Alternative 1 as the preferred alternative for the BUT-Five Points Roundabout project. A number of factors were considered in the comparison of alternatives including roundabout geometry, maintenance of traffic, truck maneuverability, potential impacts to parking in the area, and ease of use (with the circular shaped roundabout being more intuitive to drivers than the peanut shaped alternatives). In addition to these factors, more public commenters expressed a preference for Alternative 1 than for either Alternative 2A or Alternative 2B.
