**Proposed Five Points Intersection Improvement
PID 106129**

The Butler County Engineer's Office (BCEO) will host a public meeting to present information and receive feedback from the public regarding a project to improve the Five Points intersection of Hamilton Mason Road / Tylersville Road / Grand Boulevard / Hancock Avenue / Tuley Road.

The project includes converting the five road intersection to a roundabout intersection with curb and gutter, proper storm drainage, safer roadway geometrics, and improved pedestrian facilities. The project is needed because the existing signalized intersection is inefficient and results in both accidents and delays. The purpose of the project is to improve traffic operations to reduce congestion and the potential for accidents, to improve connectivity to the City of Hamilton along the Hamilton Mason Road / Grand Boulevard corridor, and to improve pedestrian mobility in the area of the intersection. The project is tentatively scheduled for construction in 2021.
