Notification of Cochran Road Bridge Closing

As you may know, the Cochran Road bridge over Indian Creek has been scheduled for replacement in 2017 and is now closed. The Butler County Engineer's Office had originally planned to start construction next week; however, we were forced to close the bridge as an emergency measure on Monday, March 13 after utility crews accidentally damaged the protective quardrail. A decision was then made to begin the bridge replacement project immediately to avoid any down time. Our contractor was ready to start and the project is now officially under way despite this week's ongoing wintry conditions.

We realize this caught many of you off guard and we apologize for the unannounced disruption. It is our normal policy to notify local residents and businesses of an upcoming road closure at least one week in advance via letters such as this, posting signs at the project site, and news releases to the media and on our web site. The circumstances with this project were unusual and out of the ordinary. Again, we're sorry for the inconvenience.

The Project

This project is necessary to replace an aging and deteriorating bridge with a new, safer structure. The old bridge was a steel beam bridge with concrete deck built in 1962. The Engineer's Office plans to replace it with a new three-span cast-in-place concrete slab structure.

A construction contract for the project has been awarded to Eagle Bridge Company of Sidney, Ohio which submitted a low bid of \$1,413,880. Funding consists of Federal grant money and local BCEO matching funds. All work is scheduled for completion by mid-July, weather permitting.

Detour and Maintenance of Traffic

During this closure, local access will be maintained for residents and businesses from the south (Ohio 129) side of the bridge, Motorists will not be permitted to pass through the construction zone and detours will be posted for all thru traffic. Northbound Cochran Road traffic will detour west on Ohio 129, north on Garner Road, and east on Reily Millville Road. Southbound traffic will reverse this route.

Emergency personnel, school bus transportation officials, the post office, and the media have been notified of this upcoming closure. The information is also posted on our web site at www.bceo.org/roadclosings.
