Notification of Hamilton Eaton Road Closing

The Butler County Engineer's Office wishes to inform you that Hamilton Eaton Road will close between U.S. 127 / Ohio 73 and Trenton Oxford Road in Collinsville beginning Monday, March 19, 2018 for a roadway improvement. The road is tentatively scheduled to reopen the week of April 23, 2018, weather permitting.

The Project

The project involves easing the curve on Hamilton Eaton Road approximately 0.2 mile north of the U.S. 127 / Ohio 73 intersection. Pavement will be added to the inside of the curve and the curve radius will be realigned. There will also be some tree and brush removal to improve sight distance.

A construction contract for the project has been awarded to W.G. Stang, LLC of Hamilton, Ohio, which submitted a low bid of \$169,448. Funding consists of 100 percent local BCEO funds.

Detours and Maintenance of Traffic

During this closure, local access will be maintained for residents, businesses, and emergency vehicles; however, detours will be posted for all thru traffic. Northbound Hamilton Eaton Road motorists will detour north on U.S. 127, east on Somerville Road, and south on Hamilton Eaton Road. Southbound traffic will reverse this route.

Emergency personnel, school bus transportation officials, the post office, and the media have been notified of this upcoming closure. The information is also posted on our web site at www.bceo.org/roadclosings. We apologize for the inconvenience and appreciate your patience.
