## **Notification of Kyles Station Road / Mauds Hughes Road Intersection Closing**

The Butler County Engineer's Office wishes to inform you that all four legs of the Kyles Station Road at Mauds Hughes Road intersection will close beginning Monday, July 10, 2017 for drainage and pavement improvements. The intersection is tentatively scheduled to reopen the week of July 31, 2017, weather permitting.

### **The Project**

The project involves replacement of existing pipes and catch basins; installing new curb and gutter; and, milling and replacement of asphalt along Kyles Station Road and the north and south sections of Mauds Hughes Road.

A construction contract for the project has been awarded to Ford Development Corporation of Sharonville, Ohio, which submitted a low bid of \$175,059. Funding consists of 100 percent Liberty Township money

### **Detours and Maintenance of Traffic**

During this closure, local access will be maintained for residents, businesses, and emergency vehicles up to the project limits, but motorists will not be permitted to pass through the actual construction zone. Detours will be posted for all thru traffic.

- **Detour for Kyles Station Road:** Eastbound Kyles Station Road traffic will detour south on Ohio 747, east on Millikin Road, and north on Yankee Road to Kyles Station. Westbound traffic will reverse this route.
- **Detour for Mauds Hughes Road:** Northbound Mauds Hughes Road traffic will detour west on Millikin Road, north on LeSourdsville West Chester Road, and east on Hankins Road to Mauds Hughes. Eastbound traffic will reverse this route.

Emergency personnel, school bus transportation officials, the post office, and the media have been notified of this upcoming closure.
