Notification of Schradin Road Daily Closures

The Butler County Engineer's Office wishes to inform you that Schradin Road will be closed between California Road and George Road each weekday from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. starting Monday, March 27, 2017 for two weeks. These daily closures are necessary for crews to remove dead ash trees along the roadway.

Detour and Maintenance of Traffic

During this closure, local access to Schradin Road will be maintained for residents and businesses from either side of the work crews. Motorists may pass through but there may be delays so it is advisable to detour around the work area.

During closure times, eastbound Schradin Road traffic will detour north on California Road, east on Okeana Drewersburg Road and south on George Road to Schradin. Westbound traffic will reverse this route.

Please note that all dates are approximate and may vary due to weather and other factors out of our control which can affect the schedule. The best way for local motorists to stay informed is to check the Road Closings page on the BCEO web site at www.bceo.org/roadclosings. Emergency personnel, school bus transportation officials, the post office, and the media have been notified of these upcoming closures.
